

## God Standing With Me 2 Timothy 4:6-18

Introduction: Throughout Paul's life he faced numerous obstacles, and the Lord stood with him every step of the way. We can have confidence that the Lord stands with us in times of trouble. (Psa. 37:39-40)

### I. "THE LORD STOOD WITH ME AND STRENGTHENED ME"

- A. Paul trusted in the Lord and not man. (V. 10, 16; 7, 17-18)
- B. The Lord is with me...
  - 1. When I feel so small. (1 Sam. 17:40-47)
  - 2. When I feel like life's blessings are being taken away from me. (Job 2:1-7)
  - 3. When I must stand alone. (Elijah—1 Kings 19:11-19)
  - 4. When it storms. (Peter—Matt. 14:28-31)

- A. Paul's analogy reminds us of great biblical accounts. (David—1 Sam. 17:37; Daniel—Dan. 6:19-21)
- B. Satan tried to hinder Paul's work as a gospel preacher. (V. 13, 21; v. 14; 2 Cor. 11:13-28; Phil. 3:18, 19)
- C. It all turned out for the "furtherance (advancement) of the gospel." (Phil. 1:12; 2 Tim. 4:17)

### III. "AND PRESERVED ME FOR HIS HEAVENLY KINGDOM"

- A. *"And the Lord will deliver me from every evil work and preserve me for His heavenly kingdom."* (V. 18) Paul knew his death was eminent (V. 6), but he looked to eternity and eternal things (V. 8).
- B. We can possess that same kind of confidence.
  - 1. V. 8: "and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing."
  - 2. V. 18: "To Him be the glory forever and ever. Amen!"
