

iEvangelize
Acts 17:16-34

Introduction: Making disciples is a big point of emphasis straight from the mouth of our Lord. (Matt. 28:18-20) The apostle Paul didn't have a 100% success rate in evangelism, but he was still successful. And we can be too. Let's learn a few things from Paul to help us in our efforts to evangelize and make disciples.

I. Paul talked to anyone who would listen. (v. 17, 18, 32)

II. He looked for open doors. (v. 17-20)

III. He had a specific motivation. (v. 16, 27, 31)

IV. He was practical in his approach. (v. 22-29)

V. He talked about important foundational concepts.

Conclusion: Like anything else we talk about things we know, not about the things we don't know. Paul's success wasn't Paul. Paul's success was in believing the message of Christ enough for his own life, and caring enough about that message for other lives to talk with them about it.
