1. What's In A Name?
2. Elohim - Creator (Genesis 1:1); Covenant Maker (Gen. 6:18; 9:8-17; Chapter 17)
3. Jehovah - One with being (Exodus 3:10-16; 6:23); One who reveals God's nature
4. Adonai – Lord (Genesis 15:1-4); Acknowledging his authority over our lives. Notice how Moses was unwilling to recognize this idea (Exodus 4)
5. El Elyon – God Most High (Genesis 14:18); So-called gods do not compare.
6. El Shaddai – God Almighty (Genesis 17:1); Nourisher and provider of needs.
7. Jehovah Jireh – The LORD Will Provide (Genesis 22)
8. Jehovah Rophe – The LORD Who Heals (Exodus 15:26)
9. Jehovah Nissi – The LORD Is Our Banner (Exodus 17:15)
10. Jehovah Tsidkenu – The LORD Our Righteousness (Jeremiah 23:5-6)
11. Jehovah M'Kaddesh – The LORD Who Sanctifies (Leviticus 20:8)
12. Jehovah of Hosts – LORD Of Sabaoth - Hannah (1 Samuel 1:11); Hag. 2:4-9; 23
13. Consider some thoughts as we summarize our study.
